

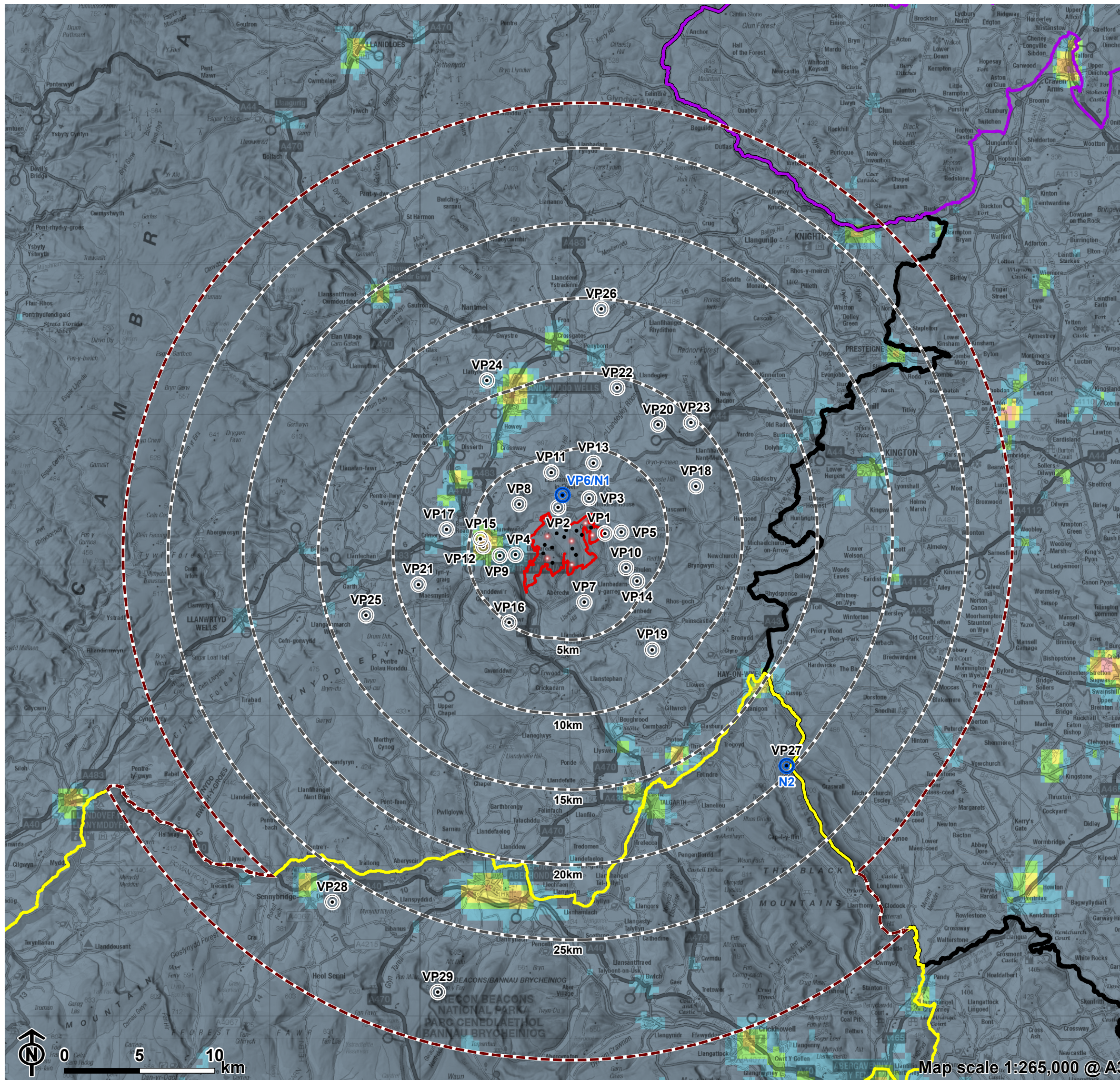


Figure 5.13a: Dark Skies within Full Study Area
