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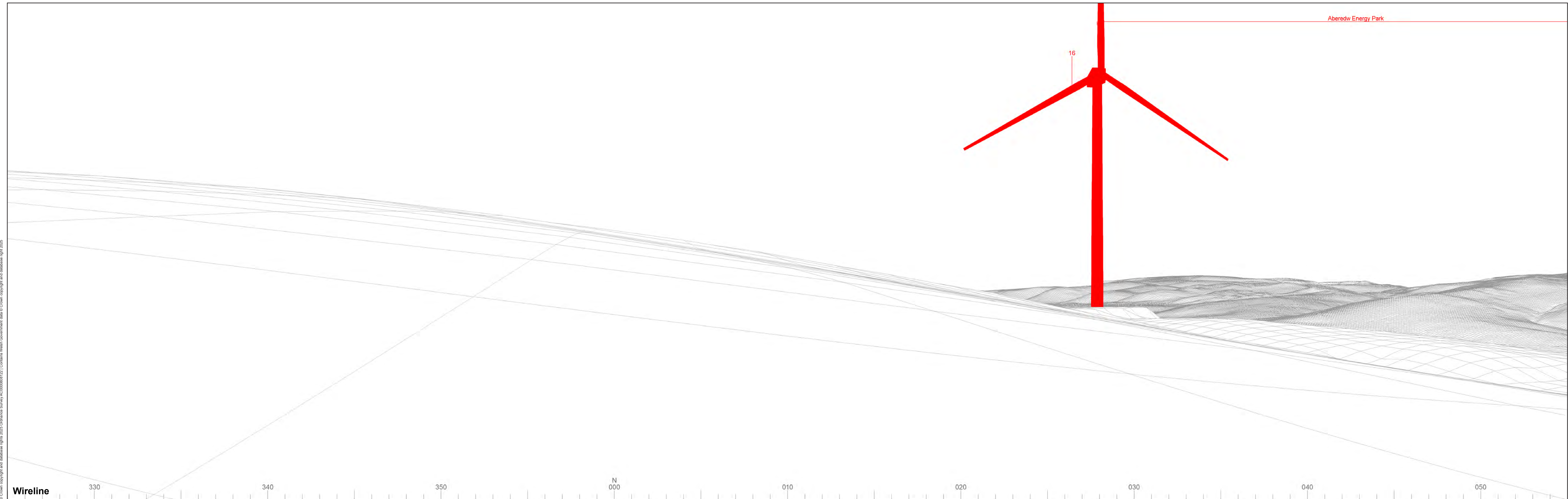
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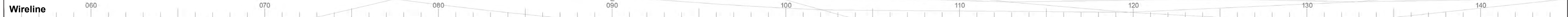
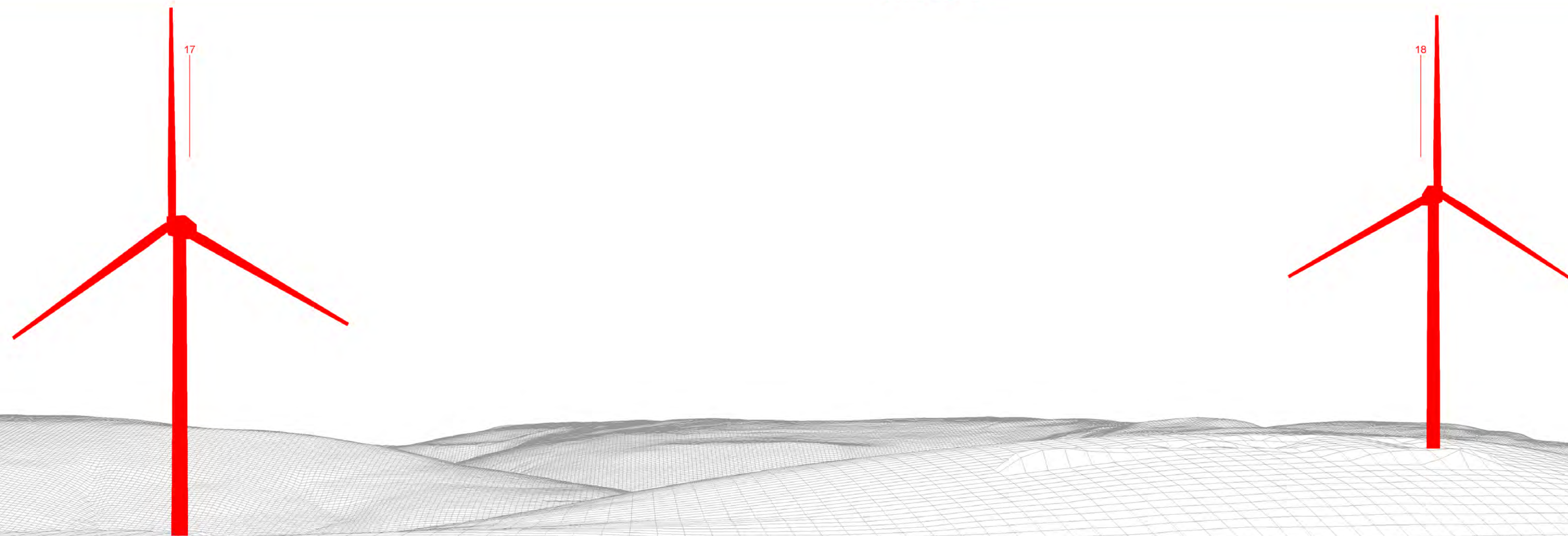
Figure 6.10: CHVP06 - Cwmblaenerw Enclosed Long Hut

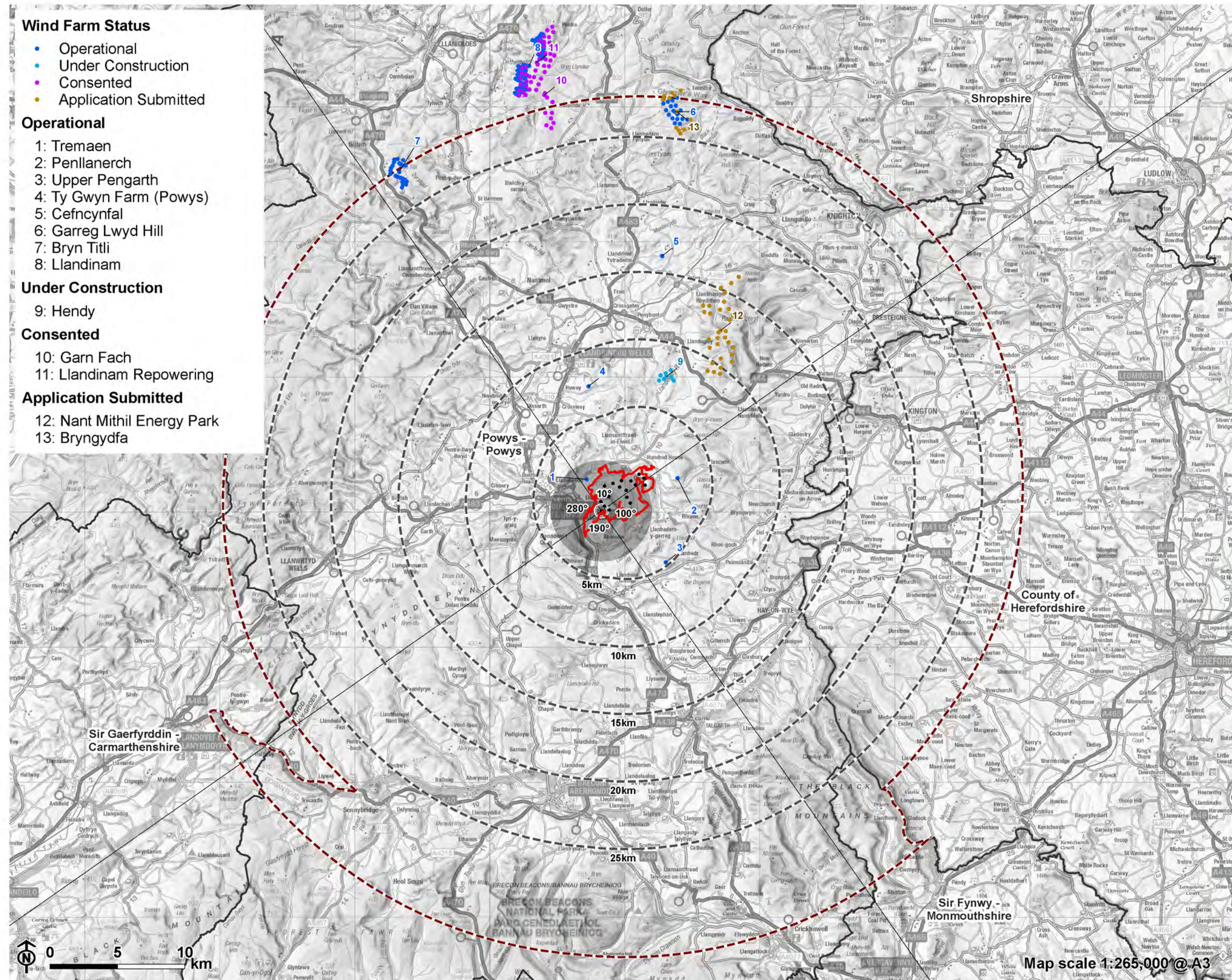

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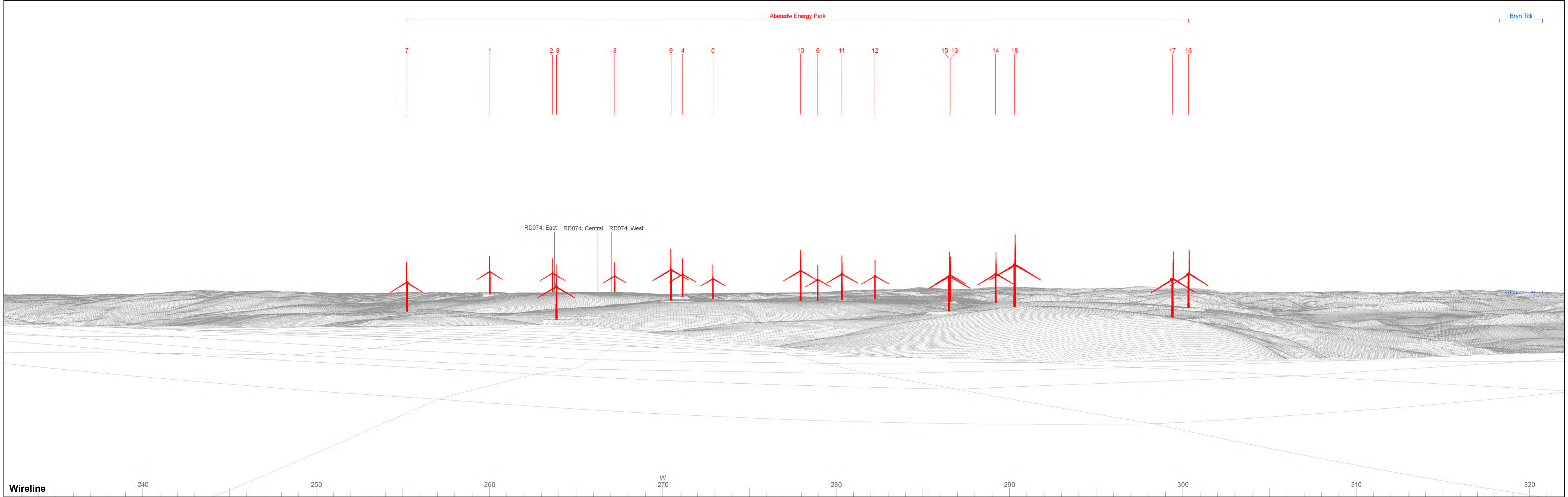
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Figure 6.14: CHVP10 - Cefn Wylfre Stone Circle and Round Barrow

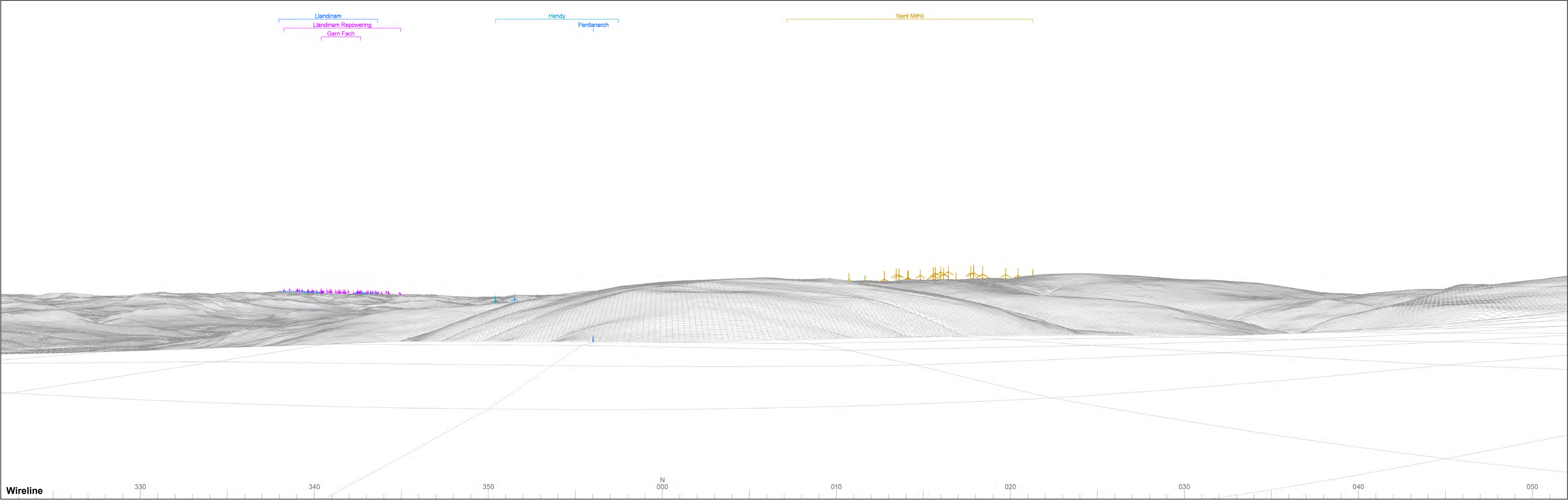

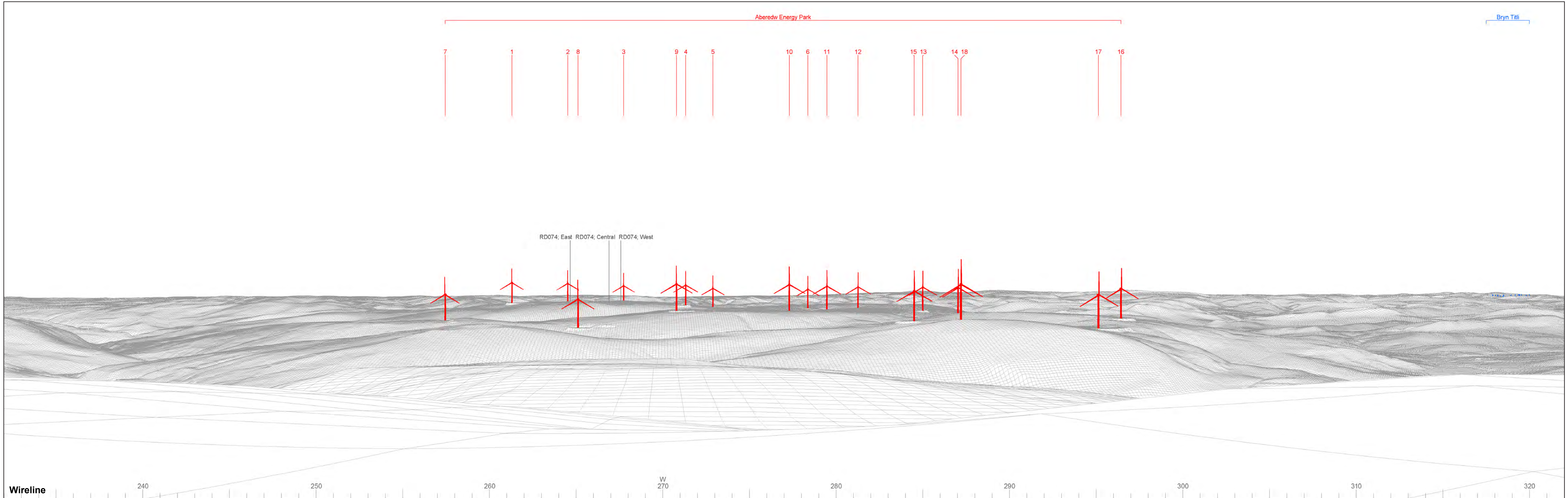


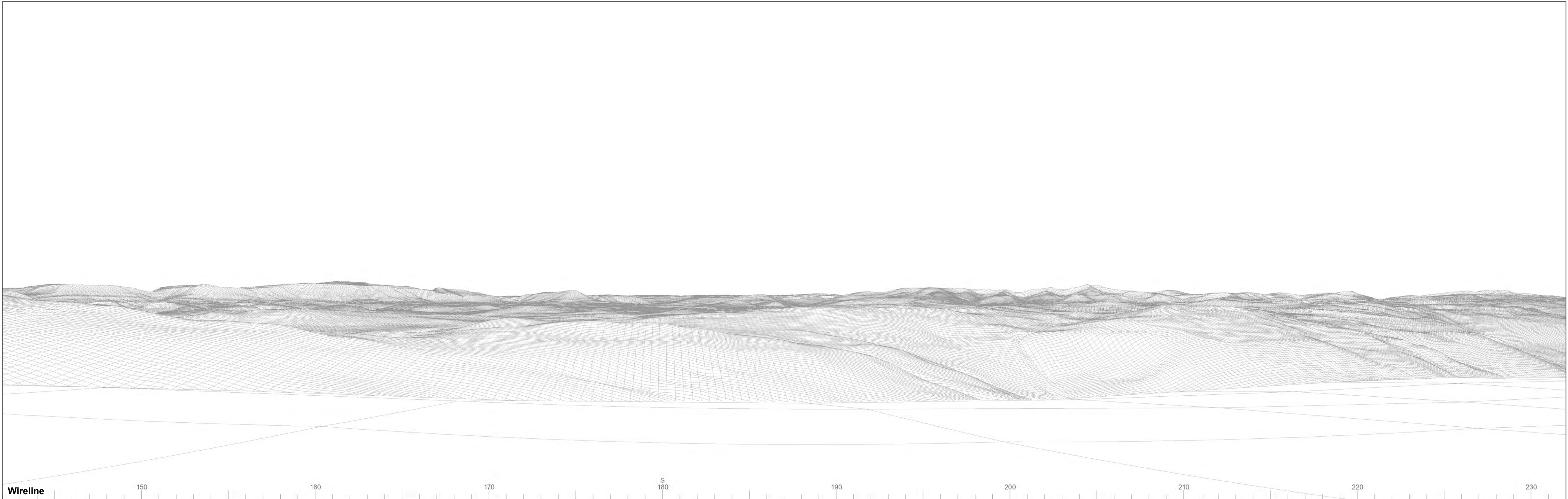
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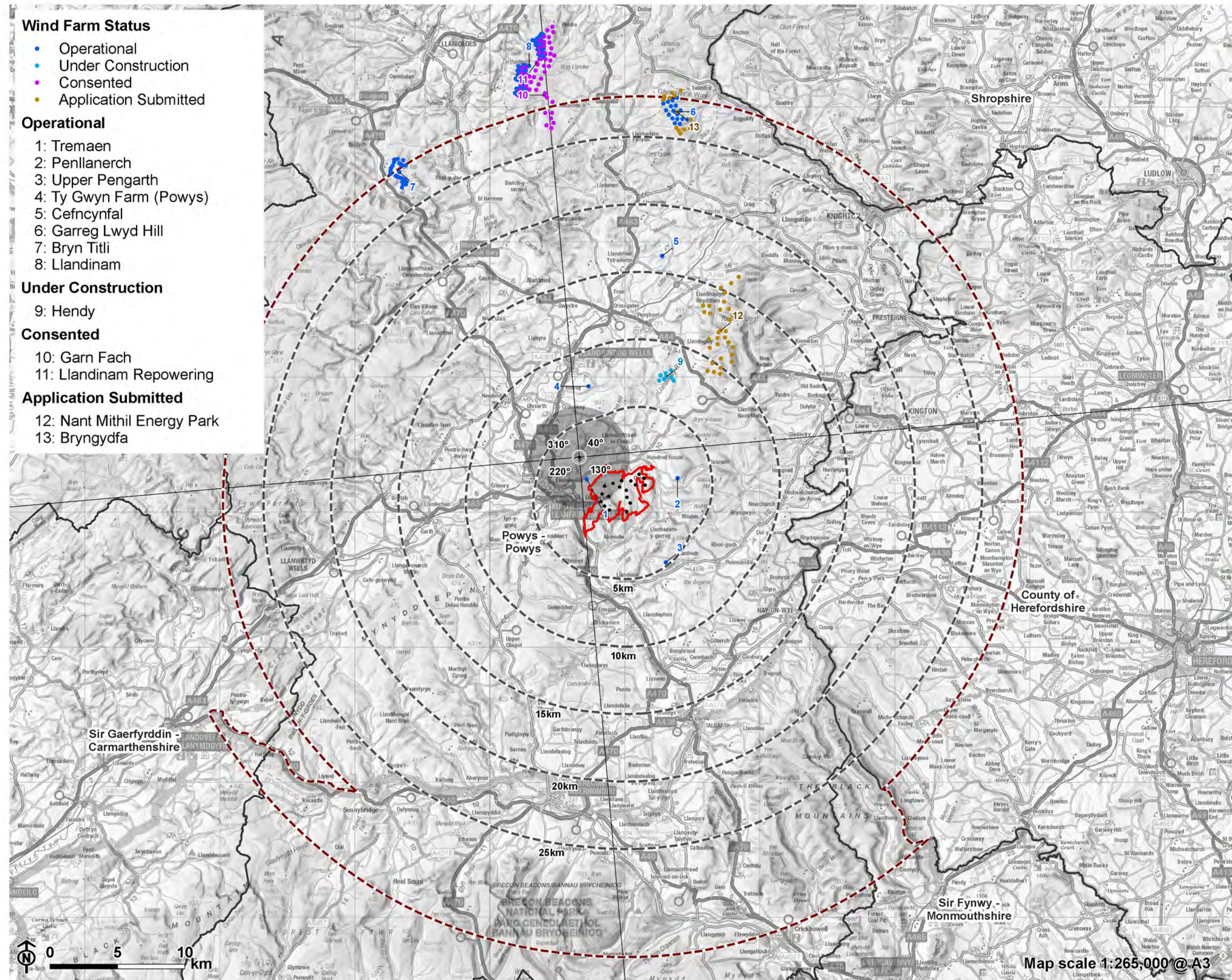


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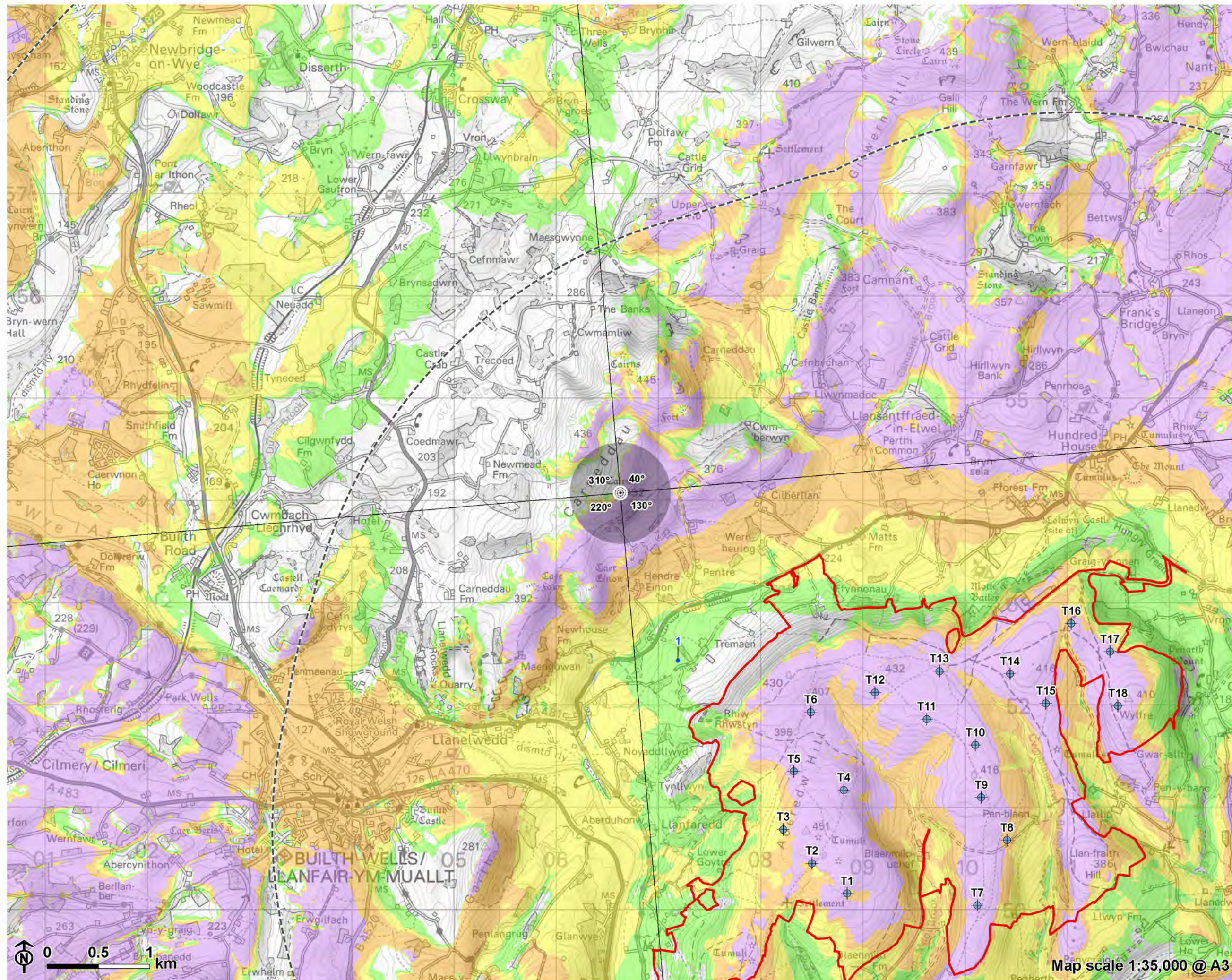








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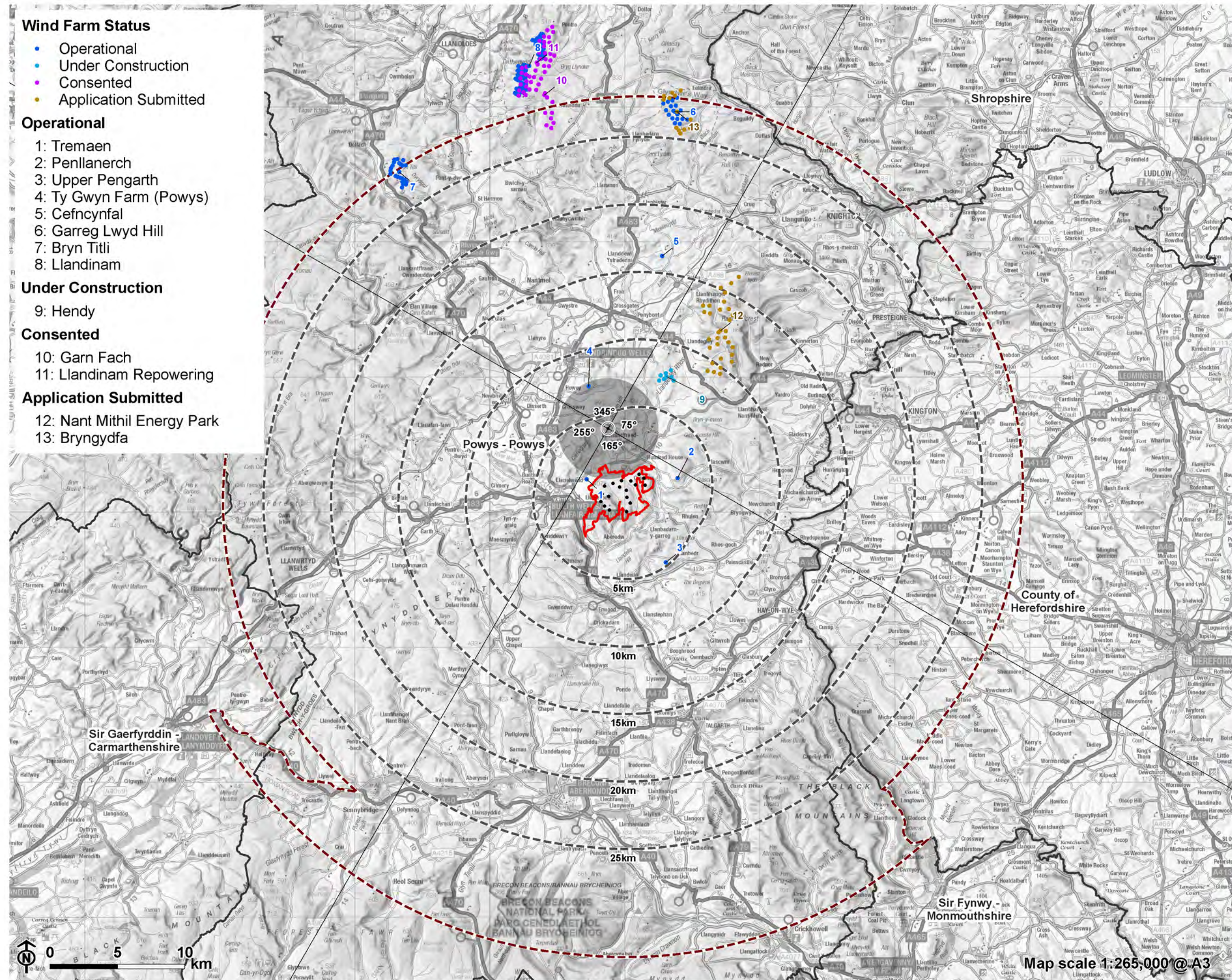
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Figure 6.16: CHVP12 - Carneddau Round Cairn

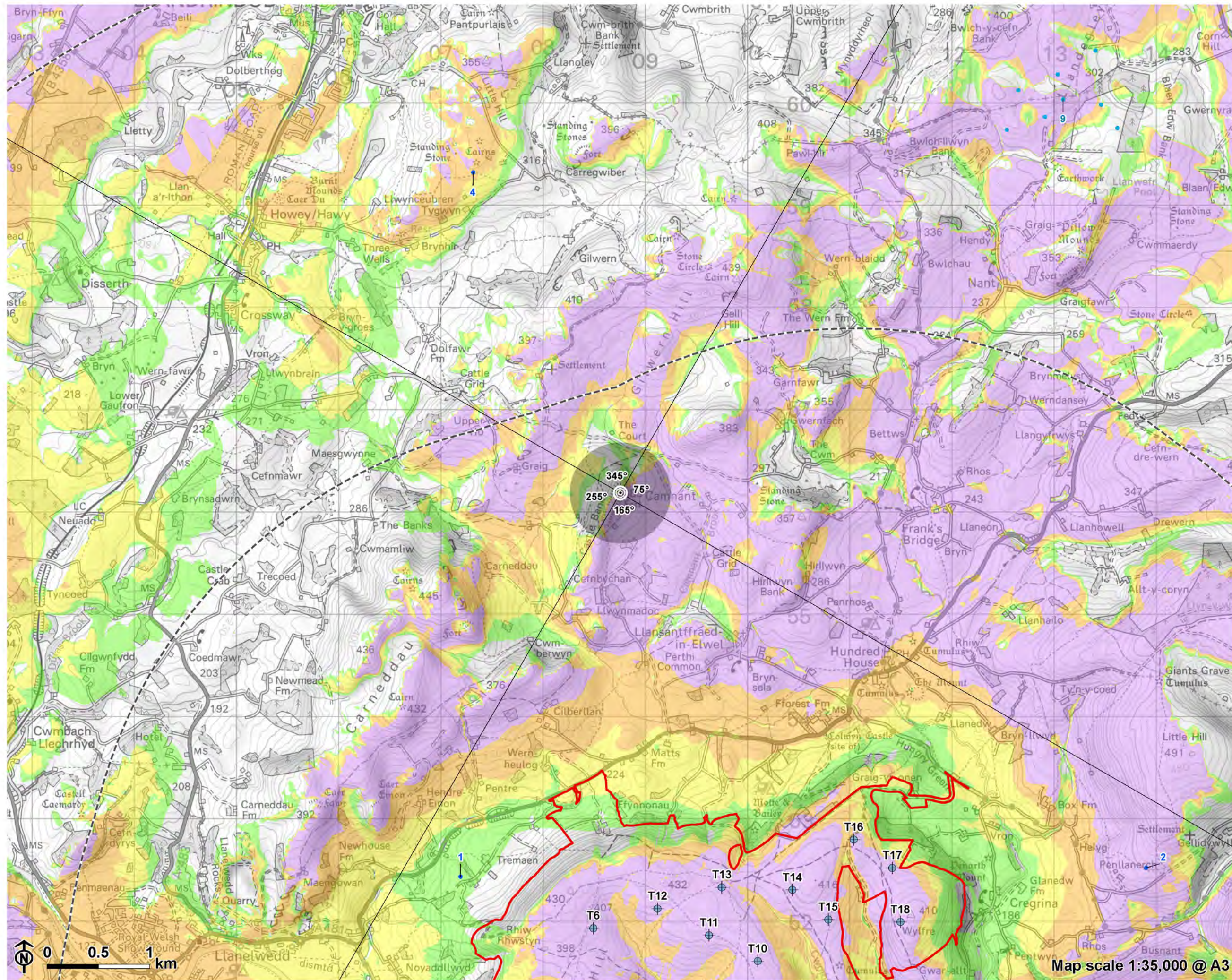

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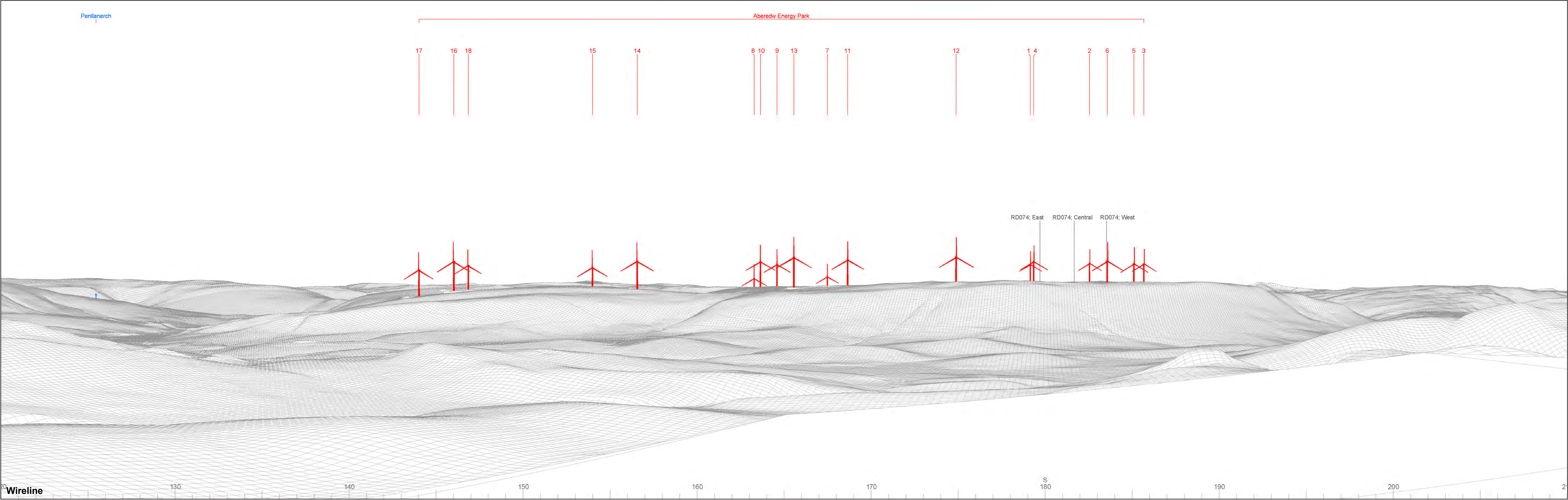
Figure 6.17: CHVP13 - Castle Bank Hillfort
